



# WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

### (Appointing a Manager for the 2023 Fair and Rodeo)

---

**WHEREAS,** The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation (“Reservation”) provides, at Article IV, Section 1(j) that the Tribal Council (“Council”) shall exercise the power “[t]o manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe including ... any other Tribal activities”, and in Article IV, Section 1(s) “to appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise, Tribal officials and employees not otherwise provided for in this constitution, and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes”; and

**WHEREAS,** to prepare for the annual White Mountain Apache Tribal Fair & Rodeo festivities, the Tribal Council shall select a Fair & Rodeo Manager; and

**WHEREAS,** the Fair & Rodeo Manager is responsible for setting up and managing the event, among other duties, as well as closing out the operation and maintaining the records for all events; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council finds it in the best interest of the Tribe to officially appoint Ty Romo to serve as the Fair and Rodeo Manager.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Ty Romo as the Fair and Rodeo Manager of the 2023 WMAT Fair and Rodeo.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on APRIL 12, 2023 duly adopted by a vote of TEN for and ZERO against with ONE abstaining by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so

ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
