

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

## (Appointing Ariane Tucker as Interim General Manager of Apache Enterprise)

- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(i) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power "[t]o manage all economic affairs and enterprises of the Tribe", and in Article IV, Section 1(s), "to appoint subordinate committees, commissions, boards, advisory or otherwise, Tribal officials and employees... and to regulate subordinate organizations for economic and other purposes"; and
- WHEREAS, on this day, via Resolution No. 09-2023-213, the Council has removed Letha Cosay from the position as Interim General Manager of Apache Enterprise and reinstated her to a previous position at the Controller's Department; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Council appoint an Interim General Manager of Apache Enterprise until a new General Manager can be advertised and the position permanently filled; and
- WHEREAS, the Council finds that appointing Ariane Tucker as the Interim General Manager will enable Apache Enterprise to continue operating with minimal disruptions, and is in the best interests of the Tribe and its members.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Ariane Tucker is hereby appointed as the Interim General Manager of Apache Enterprise, effective immediately, until a new General Manager position is advertised and the position is permanently filled.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>SEPTEMBER 18, 2023</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>SEVEN</u> for, <u>ZERO</u> against, and <u>ZERO</u> abstentions by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it under the enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1, of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10,
