

## WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE

## A Sovereign Tribal Nation

## (Designating Land Assignments for District III Communities)

- WHEREAS, The Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe ("Tribe") of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation provides, at Article IV, Section 1(h) that the Tribal Council ("Council") shall exercise the power, "To regulate the uses and disposition of Tribal property"; and
- WHEREAS, District III Council Representatives presented several locations for proposed community buildings; and
- WHEREAS, The Land Board concurs with the proposed land assignments and recommends designating the parcels of land for future development of community based projects and buildings; and
- WHEREAS, Council finds that designating several land assignments (see attached maps) for District III communities is in the best interests of the Tribe and its members.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby designates land assignments for the District III communities and that Land Office coordinates with District III Tribal Council members in identifying each assigned parcel (see attached maps).
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event this Resolution directly conflicts with the Tribal Constitution, Tribal Ordinances, or any material facts concerning the issues presented are later found to be false, this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and have no legal effect.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that in the event that this Resolution conflicts with a prior Resolution or Policy, this Resolution shall supersede and govern over the conflicting subject matter.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on MARCH 6, 2024 duly adopted by a vote of EIGHT for, ONE against, and TWO abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it underthe enumerated powers listed in Article IV, Section 1 of the WMAT Constitution, so ratified on November 10, 2021, and federally recognized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
